This tiny gem has a powerhouse of a kitchen. One of our favorite almost-casual date spots in the city. New American small plates with happy hour all day Sunday and Monday!

# To do

## PIKE PLACE FISH MARKET - FISH THROWING 1

Sure, it's touristy, but it's a Seattle tradition. This stall in Pike Place Market has been selling fish for decades, complete with employees playfully throwing the fish around.

## OLYMPIC SCULPTURE PARK - SAM 1

This park, created and operated by the Seattle Art Museum, is free and open to the public. Stroll through a 9-acre outdoor sculpture museum and enjoy concerts in the summer.

## SMITH TOWER OBSERVATION DECK & CHINESE ROOM 3

Experience the iconic, world-famous Smith Tower Observatory with its historic Otis elevators, stunning 360-degree views of Seattle, and open-air viewing deck.

## COLUMBIA TOWER SKY VIEW OBSERVATORY 3

Skip the Space Needle and come here instead! View the city from the 73rd floor! At nearly 1,000 feet it offers the tallest public viewing area in the Pacific Northwest. The 360 degree panoramic view includes Mt. Rainier, Bellevue, the Cascade Mountains, Mt. Baker, Elliott Bay, the Olympic Mountains, the Space Needle and the city.

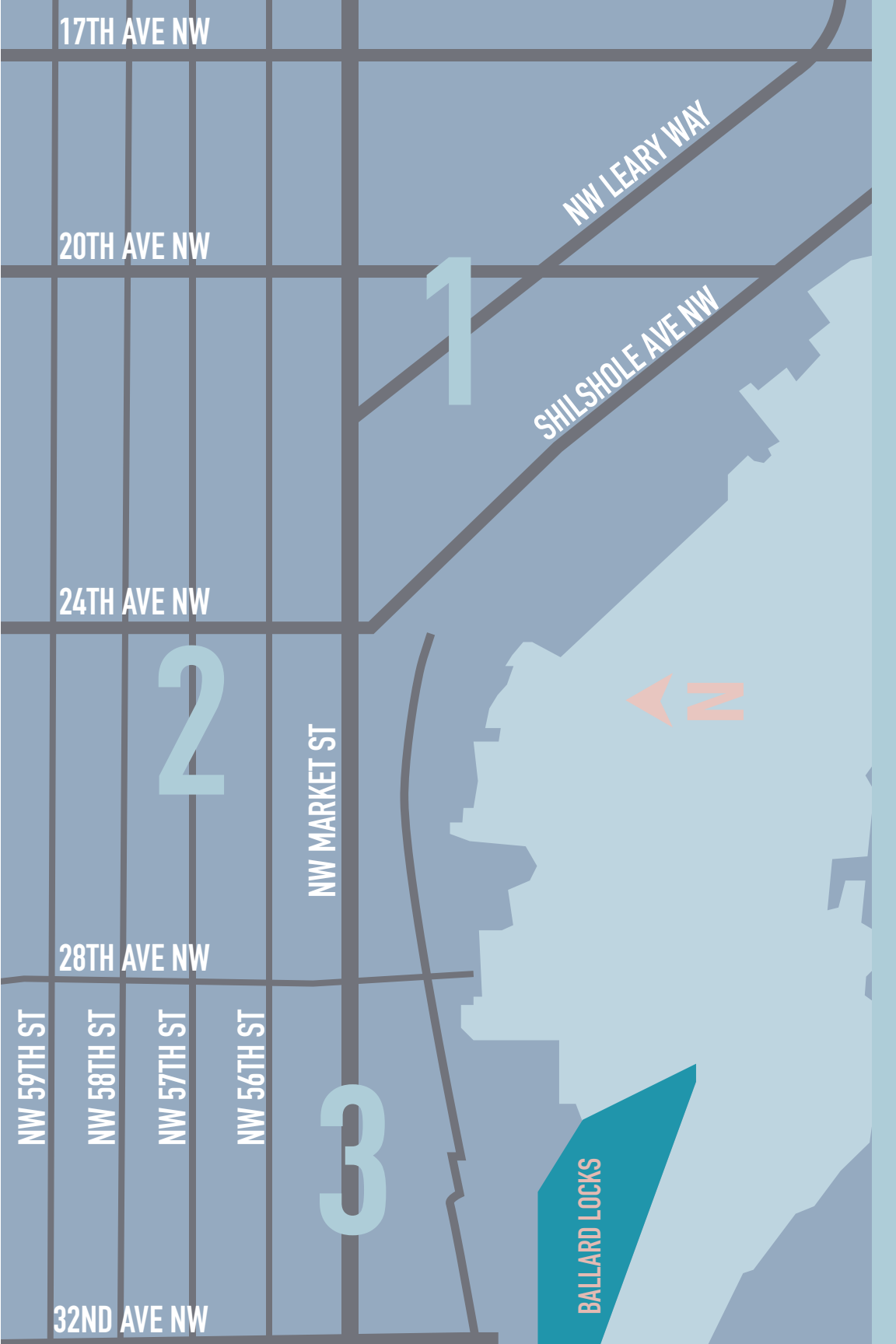

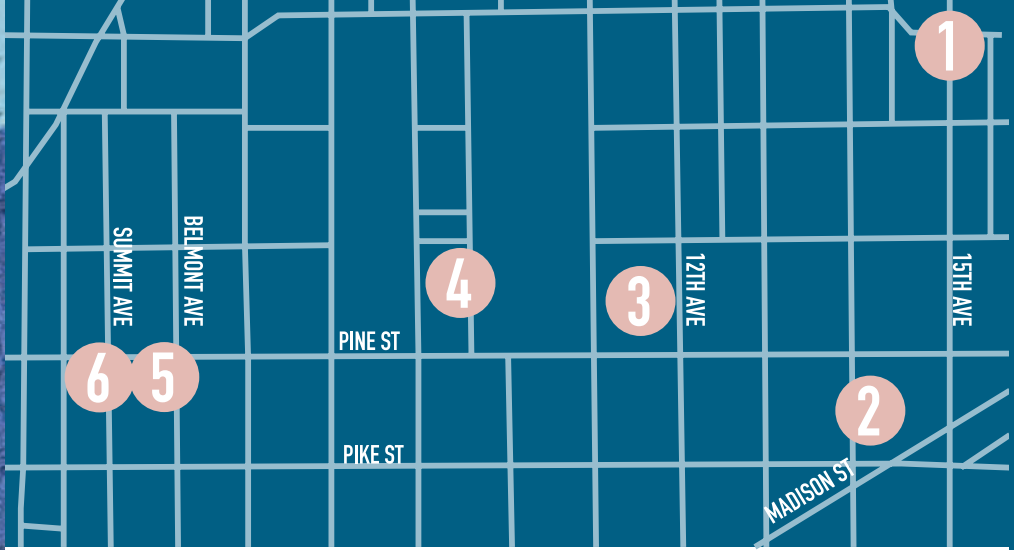


## Lower Capitol Hill Urban Art Walk

- 1. FRED'S WILDLIFE VASES**  
Fred's Wildlife Refuge is an immersive event space that often hosts all ages events.
- 2. SMOKE SHOP ALLEY**  
This alley has a lot of classic graffiti styles. It's tucked away so it's easy to miss, but worth the find.
- 3. THE REEF**  
Previously a red brick building, the new owners revamped the outside to match their new aquatic-themed weed shop. The artist, Weirdo Cult, has several iconic murals around the city.
- 4. CRAWFORD ALLEY**  
The Crawford alleyway is a tagging favorite among local street taggers. The Building's management rarely covers up the art so there is always a rotation of new art covering up the old.
- 5. GOLDFINCH AND RIBBON MURAL**  
This mural pays tribute to the Washington state bird, the goldfinch.
- 6. TETRIS MURAL**  
This mural takes a rather mundane wall and makes it vibrant with the video game classic, Tetris!

- 1. DAY SCHOOL MURAL**  
This mural was a solution to a tagging problem. Now, the fence struts its stuff, brightly colorful and playful.
- 2. LOVECITYLOVE MURAL**  
Known to periodically change, the face of MLK is the second installment on the wall. Love City Love is a nonprofit event space, hosting a myriad of functions including art shows, parties, and special classes. Places like this help bind the arts community together.
- 3. URBAN ARTS MURAL**  
Urban Arts Murals exist across the city. They are part of an initiative to clean up the industrial neighborhoods with art and discourage tagging. Urban Arts works with at-risk youth to empower them and give them tools for the future.
- 4. KURT COBAIN MURAL**  
Tucked away by the park, the city remembers their own with this Kurt Cobain mural. It's near Cal Anderson Park, which was designed by the Olmstead Brothers. (Their father designed Manhattan's famous Central Park) It has a beautiful fountain towards the north end.
- 5. TAG AREA ON BELMONT**  
Great area to see the styles of local, up-and-coming street artists.

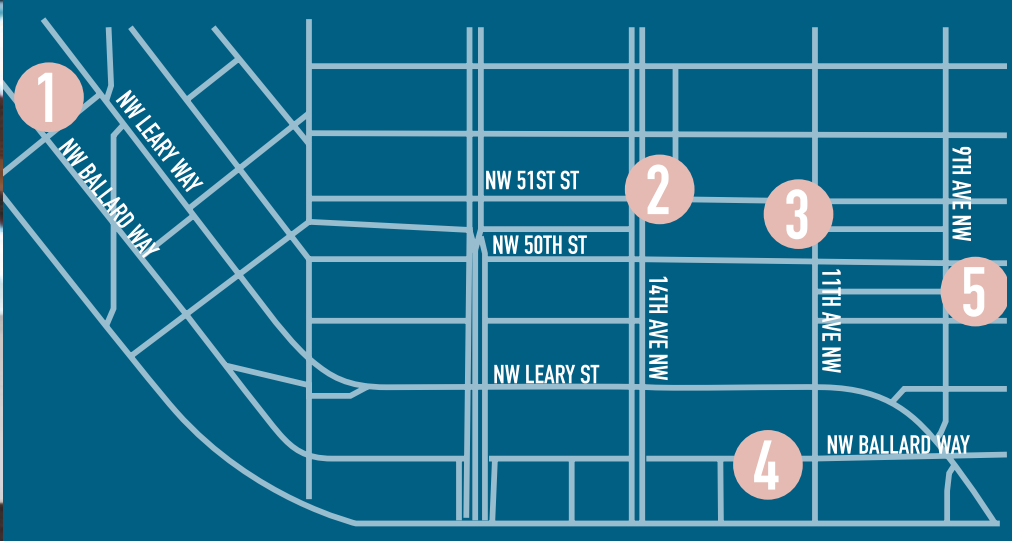
